## **ACCEPTABLE ITEMS:**

- Unused prescription medications\*
- Expired prescription medications\*
- Prescription cough syrup
- Prescription eye drops
- Expired over-the-counter medications
- Residential sharps\*\* (needles/syringes)

## **UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS:**

- Institutional or business waste
- Non-prescription liquids
- Latex gloves
- Household Chemical Waste
- \* Keep pharmaceuticals in their original containers with labels to identify contents; patient names are <u>not</u> required and may be obliterated or blacked-out.
- \*\* Sharps need to be placed in a rigid container; empty sharps containers available upon request.

The Solid Waste Agency of Northern Cook County's Prescription Drug/Sharps Disposal Program ensures environmentally-safe disposal and guards against potential theft associated with disposing of old medications. The program is for residentially-generated unused prescriptions, expired over-the-counter drugs, and needles known as "sharps." One-quart sharps containers are available upon request at designated drop-off locations. No commercial or institutional waste will be accepted. The Kenilworth Police Department serves as a collection point for this program, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
